The Colorado School of Mines in Golden, Colorado, USA is offering a PhD program within the Advanced Steel Processing and Products Research Center (http://aspprc.mines.edu) to a materials science student with a MS degree from the Montanuniversität Leoben.

The program duration would be about 4 years.

A good command of English (spoken and written) is required. The application has to be submitted before the middle of January 2017, and contain GRE Scores, if available. Admission would be for August 2017. Tuition fees, health insurance, living expenses (stipend) and research expenses would be covered by the Advanced Steel Processing and Products Research Center.

The project will deal with sheet, plate and bar steels with the focus on microstructure development and/or mechanical behavior.

Golden is a city with a population of around 20,000 and located approximately 15 miles next to the city center of Denver.
